The Central Institute of Educational Technology (CIET), a constituent of the National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) invites eligible candidates to fill up the following posts (**on purely contractual basis**) to work for the **different projects**. The selected candidates shall have to work at CIET-NCERT, New Delhi-110016 initially up to **31<sup>st</sup> March, 2027**. These posts are purely temporary and are on contractual basis.

**IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS**

1. Experience pertaining to Research/ Teaching/ Training/ Extension Activities/ eContent Development should be insisted upon in relation to school education.
2. The candidate who claims the required experience needed for the particular position (having consolidated remuneration of Rs. 40,000/- and above) shall compulsory submit, at the time of interview, an **attested copy of the salary slip/ bank statement/ ITR** of the period for which experience is claimed as evidence for having gained the requisite years of experience where the experience forms as one of the essential eligibility conditions.
3. Time spent by a candidate for pursuing M.Phil. and/or PhD degree shall not count as teaching or research experience for the purpose of eligibility for engagement/ employment.
4. It is the responsibility of the candidates to ensure that they fulfil the eligibility conditions in terms of (i) educational qualifications (ii) experience, etc.
5. These posts are purely temporary and the number of posts may increase/decrease as per need and requirement of the project at any stage.
